First Tournament of the Season, Sunday, February 24 Bartley Cavanaugh Golf Course, 8301 Freeport Blvd. Sacramento, CA (916) 665-2020

So, here we go for another fun year of golf! Have you brushed up your game? No matter, since we can rely on our group to work together for a good shot and score in the annual first tournament scramble. And for those who may want a brief reminder of how we play a scramble, here goes:

Each player hits a tee shot. The group determines the tee shot to use (four required from each player) from which to hit the approach shot. Each player hits an approach shot from an area within one club-length, not nearer to the hole and within the same type of lie (fairway, rough, hazard, etc.).

On the green, after choosing which ball position to putt from, the ball should be marked behind, as normal, and then marked on the side. Each player putts from the same spot and marks if their putt is not holed. Remember, if a missed putt is immediately tapped-in before other players have putted, play for that hole is ended and the score, including the stroke for the tap-in, must be recorded.

- To reduce slow play, please decide quickly which shot, and which putting line, to use.
- Remember to turn in your team's scorecard!

For this tournament, there will also be a free team colored ball contest. One member will play with the colored ball for one hole in the scramble format. Teams that don't lose it and bring back the colored balls may win a prize. Ties will be broken by a review of the scorecards by the Tournament Chairman, Bill Fung.

SWD Rule Clarification

A member has asked for a clarification of rule number 5 which says: *Water hazard holes should be played from designated tees. If your tee shot lands in the water, you may drop on the other side - 1 stroke penalty. If two consecutive shots land in the water, you must drop on the other side, total penalty -2 strokes. You may also hit from the opposite shore and take a 2-stroke penalty. However, you must also circle the strokes on that hole to indicate this option has been invoked and you will be disqualified from winning any prizes for that tournament.* This rule means that you should play a water hazard hole according to USGA rules but if you do not wish to play over the water hazard, you may drop on the other side of the water hazard with the penalties described but you are disqualified from any individual tournament score prizes for that tournament. Money hole, skins, and closest-to-the-pin prizes are still available to be won.
