THE FOLLOWING ARE POLICIES OF POPPY HILLS GOLF COURSE:

CHECK IN: All tournament participants scheduled to play are required to check in with the Tournament Director, Bill Fung, 45 minutes prior to tee times. They are then required to check in at the Golf Shop. **All NCGA members must have their GHIN # and a picture ID.**

DRESS CODE: No tee shirts, tank tops, or denim jeans. Men must wear shirts with collars and sleeves. Shorts must have an inseam of at least four (4) inches.

NON-METAL SPIKES ARE REQUIRED.

GATE FEES: NCGA members and guests accompanying them do not have to pay the entrance fee to Pebble Beach. Show the NCGA membership card, sticker or give the GHIN number to Security Personnel at the gate.

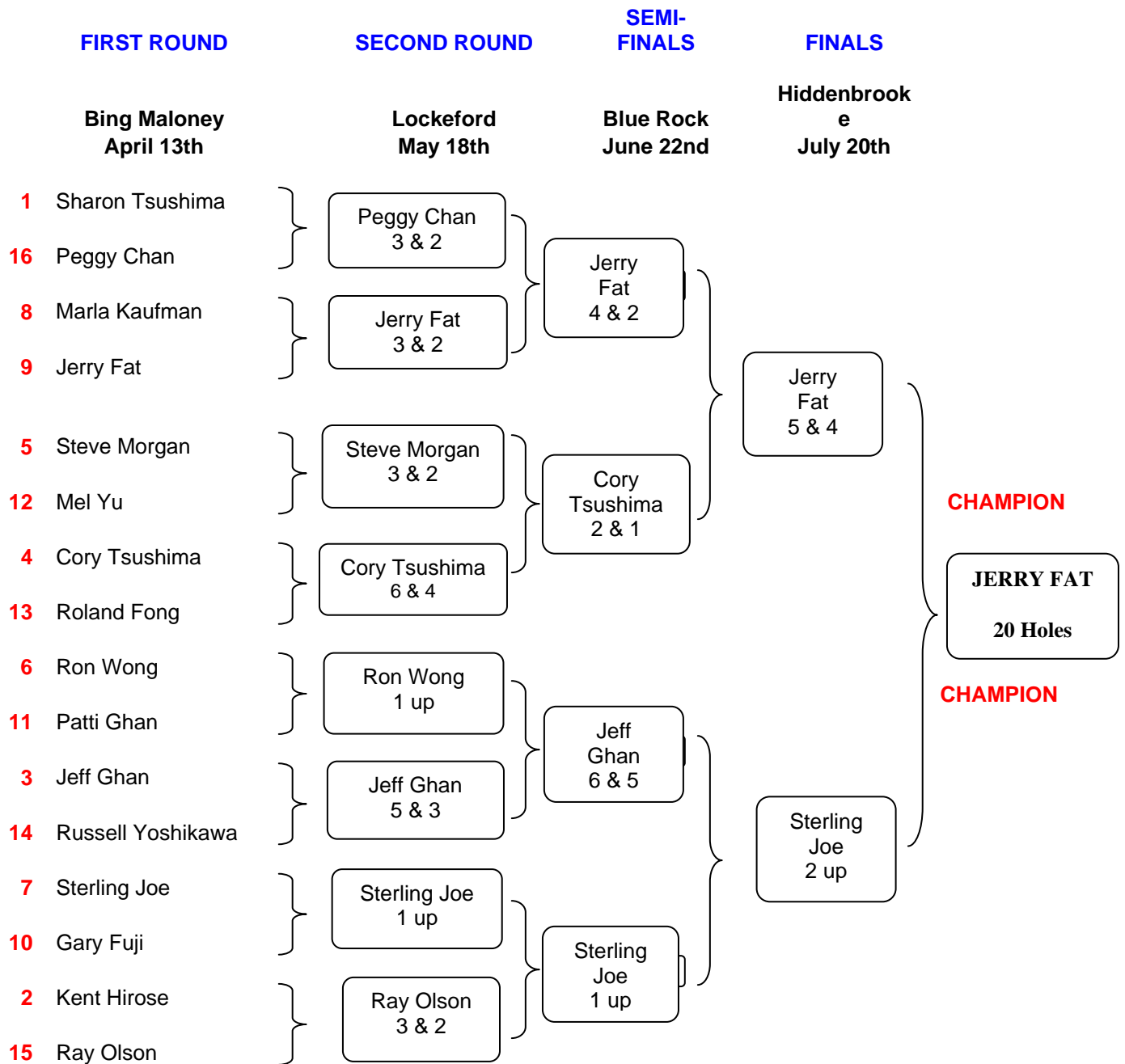

Tournament Format: Medal play

As you know, we are using the same venues as last year for our Club Championship. It is a two day event in one weekend at two different courses. To be eligible to be a Club Champion, one must sign up for and participate in both events. Payment of fees for both days must be made at check-in on Saturday.

Each day's tournament is its own event with regular tournament prizes and contests available. For the causal golfer who does not wish to be involved in the club championship, one can play in just one of the two events, or even in both events – just for the fun of it. The casual golfer is still eligible for the regular tournament prizes (golf balls) for the closest to the pin and (cash) for the optional skins and money hole contests.

The line dividing the “A” flight and “B” flight for the men will be determined by our Handicap Chairman after receiving all the commitments for playing in the Championships. The two flights will contain equal amount of participants. If there is an odd number of participating men golfers, “A” flight will receive the extra participant. Casual players will not be a factor in this determination. They will play in the flight where their indices lie.

Men's “A” Flight will play from Blue Tees (both courses)

Men's “B” Flight will play from White Tees (both courses)

Women's Flight will play from Red Tees (both courses)

The deadline for sign-ups and cancellations is September 5th.
