Tournament Format: Medal play

As you know, we are trying a new format this year for our Club Championships. It is a two day event in one weekend at two different courses. To be eligible to be a Club Champion, one must sign up for and participate in both events.

For the casual golfer, one can play in just one of the two events or even in both events for the fun of it. The casual golfer is eligible for the regular tournament prizes (golf balls, closest to the pin, optional skins and money hole).

The line dividing the "A" flight and "B" flight for the men will be determined by our Handicap Chairman after receiving all the commitments for playing in the Championships. The two men's flights will contain equal amount of participants. If there is an odd number, the "A" flight will receive the extra participant. Players will play both days in their flight assigned in the first tournament. Casual players will not be a factor in this determination. They will play in the flight where their indices lie.

Men's "A" Flight will play from Blue Tees (both courses)

Men's "B" Flight will play from White Tees (both courses)

Women's Flight will play from Gold Tees (both courses)
